

### Language, literacy and communication

**Task** - Think of songs that mean something to you and your life... Imagine you had to create an album called, 'Now That's What I call Me!' What songs would you include? Watch this video with some Year 7 teachers explaining which songs make them happy.

**Task** - Can you create an explanation/narrative to explain why these album songs are important to you? You could record this anyway you choose i.e. PowerPoint/Hwb/FlipGrid. Could you include some Cymraeg?

### Mathematics and Numeracy

**Task** - Investigate 'You and your measurements'. Can you estimate and measure the length, height and circumference of your body? Can you compare those to other people within your house?

**Task** - Imagine you had to design a 'Happy' garden space with set measures and things to include. What would it look like? Design the garden focusing on perimeter and area.

### Health and Wellbeing

**Task** - Can you create a profile, 'All About Me'? You could include information about your family, friends, interests, talents, what makes you unique? What makes you happy? What do you want to achieve? How can you best present this?

**Task** - Think of some questions you would like to ask your next teacher or another pupil about school. Can you record these questions maybe through Hwb or using Flipgrid so that your next teacher can try and answer them?

### Science and Technology

**Task** - Think of an area or habitat that makes you happy e.g. your room/stables/park/school. Create a labelled diagram/design of it either on paper or using a computer design program such as SketchUp/CAD/J2E

**Task** - Create a model version of an area or habitat that makes you happy. You could use materials you have around the house. Could you set yourself the challenge of working to scale?

### Expressive Arts

**Task** - Can you design a cover album for the 'Now That's What I Call Me' cd? You could be as creative as you wish. Explore different art styles and work with different art mediums e.g. paint/pastels/natural resources.

**Task** - Listen to the songs 'Happy' by Pharrell Williams/Hapus. Can you create a rhythm or lyric that tells us more about you or what makes you happy? You could even record your version using GarageBand for example.

### Humanities

**Task** - Can you create a map/collage of an area/location that makes you happy? You could include drawings/diagrams/pictures to explain why this place makes you happy.

**Task** - Think of somebody you know who makes you happy i.e. a family member or friend. Video call or speak to them and hold an interview to ask what makes them happy. How could you record their answers?
